Please read and comply with these original instructions prior to the initial operation of your appliance and store them for later use or subsequent owners.

Proper use

The pipe cleaning kit is intended for use with KÄRCHER high pressure cleaners only.

The pipe cleaning kit is suitable for cleaning pipes and drains with dimensions as seen in the illustration **1** on the interior book sleeve.

Safety instructions

Hazard levels

⚠ DANGER

Pointer to immediate danger, which leads to severe injuries or death.

⚠ WARNING

Pointer to a possibly dangerous situation, which can lead to severe injuries or death.

⚠ CAUTION

Pointer to a possibly dangerous situation, which can lead to minor injuries.

ATTENTION

Pointer to a possibly dangerous situation, which can lead to property damage.

Safety instructions

⚠ DANGER

- Please observe the safety instructions of your high pressure cleaner.
- Only trigger the high-pressure jet when the nozzle has been inserted into the pipe to be cleaned at least up to the red marking.
- Never pull the inserted pipe cleaning hose out of the pipe to be cleaned any further than the red mark during the high-pressure operation.
- In unfavourable conditions, the pipe cleaning hose can change direction inside the pipe and come back out of it. This risk grows with the diameter of the pipe to be cleaned. If this occurs, immediately release the lever of the hand spray gun.

- If the cleaning operation has been completed turn off the high-pressure cleaner and disconnect the pipe cleaner from the high-pressure gun.

⚠ WARNING

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities. The appliance must not be operated by children or persons who have not been instructed accordingly. Children should be supervised to prevent them from playing with the appliance.

- Maximum water temperature 60 °C (please observe the instructions of your high pressure cleaner).

⚠ CAUTION

- When cleaning the insides of pipes with a hose line, the accident prevention regulation BGR 500, Chapter 2.3.6 must be adhered to!

Application

- Select the cleaning nozzle to match the high pressure cleaner.

Illustrations on the inside of the front cover

Illustration 2

- Screw the pipe cleaning nozzle onto the pipe cleaning hose.
- Connect the pipe cleaning hose with the hand spray gun of the high pressure cleaner.

⚠ DANGER

Risk of injury! Do not connect the pipe cleaning hose to the high pressure cleaner unless a hand spray gun is installed. Before each use, check that the red marking ring is tight and is at the correct distance of 50 cm to the nozzle.

Illustration 3

- Insert the pipe cleaning hose into the pipe to be cleaned up to the red mark.

Illustration 4

- Turn on the high-pressure cleaner.

Illustration 5

- Press the lever of the hand spray gun and manually guide the pipe cleaning hose with the automatic advance.

Note:

If the pipe cleaner encounters a clogged spot:

- Press the lever of the high-pressure gun repeatedly and release again.

Repeat this cleaning process if necessary or with severe contamination!

- Pull the pipe cleaning hose out of the pipe up to the red mark with the high pressure cleaner running.

- Switch off the high pressure cleaner.

Illustration 7

- Pull the pipe cleaning hose out of the pipe.
